

How To Register for the ACT and Send Scores to ASMSA for 2026-2027 Application

1. **Identify a test date** that fits your schedule. Test dates are included below and can be found [here](#). ASMSA requests that students take the ACT no later than February 27th, 2027 to ensure scores are received in time for application review.

2. **Begin the registration process** at my.act.org. If you have tested before, log in with the information you used the last time and skip to Step 6. If you have not tested, click “Create MyACT account” and then “I’m New! Let’s get started.”

15. **Finalize your registration** and **save your confirmation ticket** as well as any information you receive from ACT via email. You will need the testing ticket to enter the testing center on your test date.

What are Your Next Steps?

You must upload a photo to ACT prior to the date indicated on your registration. This photo will be checked against a photo ID on the day of testing to prove your identity.

If you do not have an acceptable photo ID (city/state/federal OR school ID) then you will need to complete the Student Identification form which requires you to attach a photo and have the document notarized by a notary or signed by a school official.
